MINIMUM HEIGHT REQUIREMENT AND SPACE NEEDED

- Same as for the Southpaw Therapy Net: 8 feet
- Use caution to keep a clear distance of 6 feet from all walls and other obstacles

HEIGHT ADJUSTER AND SAFETY ROTATIONAL DEVICE NEEDED

- A Southpaw Height Adjuster is recommended for ease in adjusting your net to the correct height.
- A Southpaw Safety Rotational Device must be used to prevent stress on your suspension system and damage to your net

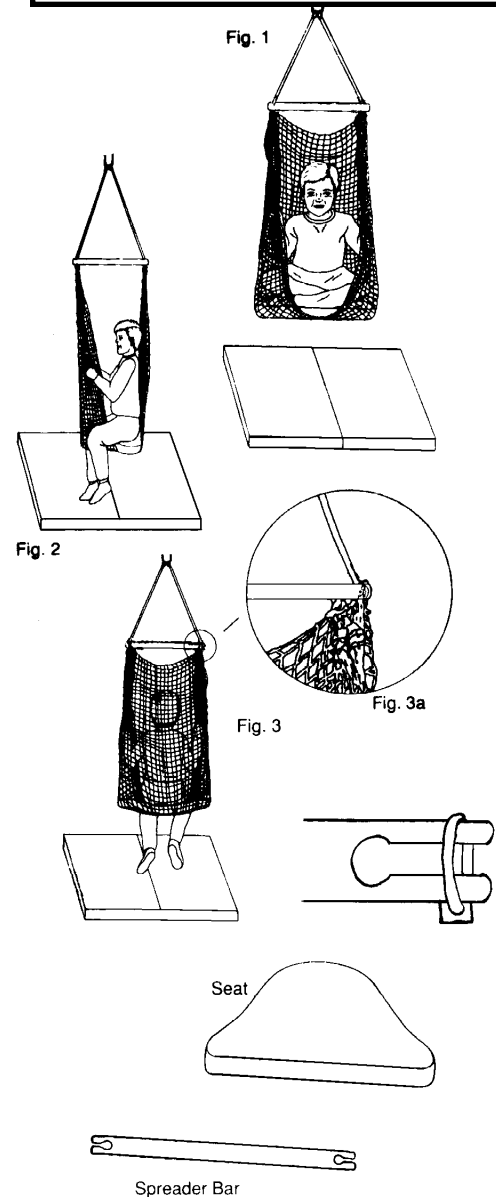
WORKING LOAD

- 200 lbs. when used with Southpaw Therapy Net (Not included).

Typical Seating Styles

1. Remove the two retaining pins from the top spreader bar and set aside. Do not lose these pins. Slip the upper cords at the top of a Southpaw Therapy Net into the slots at either end of the top spreader bar (see Fig. 1), and replace the retaining pins. The insert seat is simply positioned in the bottom of the net. It can be used with the client sitting with the net to either side (see Fig. 1) or straddling the net in front, (see Fig. 2).
2. For extra back support: begin by following step one. With the spreader bar and seat in place, gather two or three loops of a section of the Therapy Net on one side. Slide these loops into the slot of the spreader bar on the same side (fig 3a). Replace the

retaining pin into that side of the spreader bar, making sure all of the



therapy Net is "trapped" by the pin. Repeat this step for the other side of the Therapy Net(Fig 3). Adjust as needed.

MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

All of the following wear points should be checked on a monthly basis and recorded on the checklist enclosed:

- Check the top spreader bar for cracks or splinters. If cracks are found, discontinue use. If splinters are found, sand smooth and refinish.
- Check seat insert for worn upholstery or loose staples. If loose staples appear, discontinue use immediately.
- Always check height adjustment system before using to see that it is working properly.
- Check net wear points before using with the Net Adaptation Kit.

STORAGE PROCEDURES

- Store out of direct sunlight
- Store where not accessible by clients without proper supervision

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- Each piece of the Net Adaptation Kit can be cleaned with a damp cloth and mild disinfectant

MATTING PRECAUTIONS:

- FLOOR MATS OF PROPER THICKNESS SHOULD BE POSITIONED APPROPRIATELY UNDER AND AROUND THE SUSPENDED EQUIPMENT.

CAUTION

- ◆ **Check ceiling eye bolt for wear and movement. Use a Southpaw Safety Rotational Device to prevent abnormal wear.**
- ◆ **Floor mats of proper thickness should be positioned properly under and around all suspended equipment.**

In addition, the layout of your activity area, proper installation and maintenance of your equipment is critical. Southpaw equipment is not intended for recreational or outdoor use.
