Instruction Sheet Play Loft Padded Wall (Set of Three)

Store these instructions in a safe place or you may access them on our website.



Take time to familiarize yourself with the use and maintenance of this equipment before using. Please file this Instruction Sheet in an accessible location. The Instruction Sheet must be read and familiar to anyone who is using Southpaw Enterprises Equipment.

IMPORTANT: Please check equipment immediately for any damage that may have resulted during shipping. If any damage has occurred, please contact Southpaw Enterprises, Inc. immediately.

MATERIALS LIST:

- 3 - Padded Wall Panels
- 1 - Instruction Sheet
- 1 - Maintenance Checklist

Wall panels are also available individually. 53" wall # 150216. 48" wall # 150217

ASSEMBLY PROCEDURE:

- **Note** - one pad is not as wide as the other two. The narrow pad attaches to the short wall on the side where the slide connects.
- Place the black side of the padded wall against the inside of the bars.
- Wrap each of the loop strips around the end bar and secure it to the hook fastener sewn to the back of the wall by holding your hand on the inside of the wall and pressing on the strip from the outside.
- Repeat this process for each wall.



MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST:

All of the following wear points must be checked on a monthly basis and recorded on the checklist enclosed.

- Check for loose stitched or torn seams. If loose stitches or torn seams are found, discontinue use until repaired.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Check with your infectious disease department before using these procedures.
- Check for client allergies first.
- Wipe with a damp cloth using soap and water or disinfectant.
- Dry all parts before using.

STORAGE PROCEDURES:

- Store where not accessible by clients without proper supervision.
