

Instruction Sheet Play Loft White LED Rope Light 150225

Store these instructions in a safe place or you may access them on our website.



Take time to familiarize yourself with the use and maintenance of this equipment before using. Please file this Instruction Sheet in an accessible location. The Instruction Sheet must be read and familiar to anyone who is using Southpaw Enterprises Equipment.

MATERIALS LIST:

1 - 9 foot Rope Light w/cord 10 - Mounting Clips 10 - # 4 x 1/2" Phillips Head Screws 1 - Instruction Sheet

1 - Maintenance Checklist

The Rope light can be installed under the deck of the Play Loft or hand held to create a serene, calming space.

Works well in conjunction with the Hideaway Flaps.

CAUTION: Do not use without constant adult supervision.

INSTALLATION IN LOFT:

TOOLS NEEDED - Drill, 3/32" drill bit, Phillips head screwdriver.

- Arrange rope clips on the underneath side of the floor of the Loft to hold the Rope Light in the position you want. The rope clips should be spaced approximately 1 foot apart.
- Wrap a piece of tape around the 3/32" drill bit leaving 1/2" of the tip exposed. This will give you a guide so that you don't drill through the floor of the Loft. Drill a pilot hole for the screw 1/2" deep at the point where you want the rope clip.
- Insert a screw through the hole closest to the clip. Start the screw into the pilot hole and tighten the screw securely. Use caution not to over tighten the screw. This could cause the clip to break.
- After installing all of the clips, insert the Rope Light into the clips to hold it in place.
- You will most likely need an extension cord to connect the light cord to a 120 volt wall outlet. Use only a UL approved extension cord.

MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST:

All of the following wear points should be checked on a monthly basis and recorded on the checklist enclosed.

- Check that the screw on connection between the cord and the rope light is tight.
- Check the end cap on the end of the rope light is secure.
- Check the light and extension cord is not frayed exposing any wires.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Check with your infectious disease department before using these procedures.
- Check for client allergies first.
- UNPLUG FROM WALL OUTLET BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO CLEAN.
- Wipe with a damp cloth using mild soap and water of disinfectant.
- Dry before using.
