Bounce Pad Carpet Kit 151126

MATERIALS LIST

- 1 - Carpet for the Bounce Pad # 1120
- 3 - Adhesive loop squares
- 1 - Instruction Sheet
- 1 - Maintenance Checklist

Directions

Your carpet comes with the three adhesive loop squares attached to the hook squares on the bottom of the carpet.

1. Place the Bounce Pad on the floor. Place the carpet on top of the Bounce Pad, centered between the edges of the wooden platform.
2. Once the carpet is in place and square, kneel on the carpet to hold it in place. Turn one corner up, revealing the hook and loop squares. Peel the backing off of the adhesive loop square, leaving it attached to the hook square. Carefully lay the corner of the carpet back down, and press firmly on top of the corner.
3. Repeat step 2 with the remaining corners. Your carpet is now ready to use.

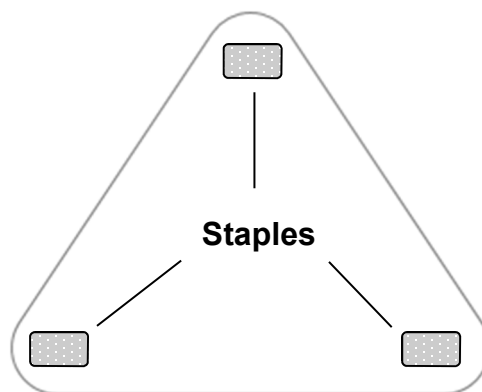
NOTE: To make sure that the adhesive squares never release from the board, you can staple them in place. Be sure to use 3/8" staples, so that they do not go all the way through the wood. Staple them according to the pattern to the right.

STORAGE PROCEDURE

- Store where not accessible by clients.
- Store out of direct sunlight.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- Vacuum carpet.
- Carpet may be cleaned with foam carpet cleaner.
- Carpet is not machine washable.
