Instruction Sheet Hand and Palm Brush 2893

MATERIALS LIST

- 1-Set of 12 Brushes
- 1—Instruction Sheet

Note: This brush is used specifically for the palms of the hands and fingers. It is firmer and courser than the surgical scrub brush (used for the rest of the body) and as a result is significantly more effective on the tougher skin of the palms and volar surfaces of the fingers.

When used properly, it facilitates individual finger awareness, and heightens motor coordinative use of each of the fingers as an individual unit of the hand.

TO USE

Passively and repeatedly brush the volar surface of each finger individually. Then have the client actively stroke the brush with each finger, encouraging individual finger flexation. Then notice the beginnings of increased spontaneity and the ability to sequentially oppose each finger to the thumb. Notice how the fingers are spontaneously used as separate units in poking, pointing, tripod grasp, oppositional prehension, and generally improved manipulative dexterity.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS
