

Instruction Sheet: Acrylic Mirrors 303105

Store these instructions along with the enclosed maintenance checklist in a safe place. You may also access them on our website.



Take time to familiarize yourself with the use and maintenance of this equipment before using. Please file this Instruction Sheet in an accessible location. The Instruction Sheet must be read and familiar to anyone who is using Southpaw Enterprises Equipment.

IMPORTANT: Please check equipment immediately for any damage that may have resulted during shipping. If any damage has occurred, please contact Southpaw Enterprises, Inc. immediately.

MATERIALS LIST:

- 1 Acrylic Mirror
- 6 Wall Anchors
- 6 Screws

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

The Acrylic comes pre-drilled with 6 holes for mounting. Position Mirror against wall where final position will be. If using with a Bubble Column Platform, position 1" above the wooden platform—DO NOT rest the Mirror on the platform. Subsequent moving of the platform may cause damage to the mirror if the mirror is resting on the platform.

With a pencil or awl, mark the 6 positions of the hole locations. Use a 3/16" drill bit at the marks to make hole for the anchors. Once all 6 holes are drilled replace the mirror and use enclosed screws to mount mirror to the wall.

DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN THE SCREWS! This may damage the Acrylic Mirror. Also, if the mirror is distorted, relax the screws to remove the distortion

MAINTENANCE:

The mirror should ALWAYS be cleaned using a soft cotton cloth. Paper towels will permanently scratch the mirror. NO AEROSOL CLEANERS OR SOLUTIONS CONTAINING ALCOHOL CAN BE USED ON THE MIRROR! Preferably, use a 1:8 solution of vinegar/water with a half teaspoon of dish detergent per quart.

Safety Precautions - The safety of your clients is dependent on the appropriate choice of activity to match, yet challenge their physical abilities. Use appropriate spotting / safety techniques. In addition, the layout of your activity area, proper installation and maintenance of your equipment is critical. Southpaw equipment is not intended for recreational or outdoor use. Under no condition should this equipment be used without proper supervision.
