INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSEMBLY

The Floor Mat comes out of the box completely assembled. In order to make the Floor Mat vibrate the product must be connected to a Southpaw Stereo Rover, Southpaw Corner or Wall Radio . Insert the RCA plug into jack on the Southpaw Stereo Rover or Radio. Use with any other stereo equipment will void the warranty.

CLEANING / INSPECTION / MAINTENANCE

Recommended cleaning solution is a 50/50 mixture of Hydrogen Peroxide and water and/or a small amount of mild detergent. Use a soft cotton cloth in conjunction with any cleaner.

MAINTENANCE

There is no regular maintenance necessary other than keeping the product clean. There should be no need to get inside the Floor Mat to access the speakers.

If vinyl should tear or rip, contact Southpaw to replace cover.

CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REMOVE ALL SHARP OBJECTS FROM POCKETS, AS WELL AS ANY METAL BRACES, PRIOR TO GETTING ON THE VIBRO-ACOUSTIC FLOOR MAT.
