INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSEMBLY

The Wedge comes out of the box completely assembled. In order to make the wedge vibrate the product must be connected to the Southpaw Radio Rover (303100) or Mini Rover (303600). Insert the RCA plug into jack on the side of the chair and the other to the Southpaw Radio Rover. Use with any other stereo equipment will void the warranty.

CLEANING / INSPECTION / MAINTENANCE

Recommended cleaning solution is a 50/50 mixture of Hydrogen Peroxide and water and/or a small amount of mild detergent. Use a soft cotton cloth in conjunction with any cleaner.

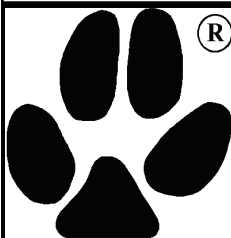
MAINTENANCE

There is no regular maintenance necessary other than keeping the product clean. The gold posts for the speaker connections can be cleaned with a damp cloth but do not get water into the post. There should be no need to get inside the wedge to access the speakers.

CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REMOVE ALL SHARP OBJECTS FROM POCKETS, AS WELL AS ANY METAL BRACES, PRIOR TO GETTING ON THE VIBRO WEDGE.
