MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST:

All of the following wear points should be checked on a monthly basis and recorded on the checklist enclosed.

- Check for delaminating of fabric. If found, discontinue use until repaired. Discard any steel shot that may come out of blanket.
- Check the hook and loop fasteners to make sure they are securely attached. If any loose stitching is found, discontinue use until repaired.

CAUTION

Fabric and adhesive are not certified fire retardant. Keep away from open flame or cigarettes. Do not place on radiators or heaters.

MATTING PRECAUTIONS:

- Always use appropriate matting.

STORAGE PROCEDURES:

- Store out of direct sunlight.
- Store where not accessible by clients without proper supervision.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Check for client allergies first.
- Check with your infectious disease department before using these procedures.
- **DO NOT DRY CLEAN!!**

Outer Cover

- Machine wash cold water - mild detergent.
- Tumble dry - **LOW HEAT. EXCESSIVE HEAT WILL DESTROY THE BLANKET.**

Inner Liner

- Spot clean using a sponge and a mild detergent. Avoid saturating the blanket near the pockets of weight, as excessive water could cause the steel media inside to rust. Air dry.

Safety Precautions - The safety of your clients is dependent on the appropriate choice of activity to match, yet challenge their physical abilities. Use appropriate spotting / safety techniques. In addition, the layout of your activity area, proper installation and maintenance of your equipment is critical. Southpaw equipment is not intended for recreational or outdoor use. Under no condition should this equipment be used without proper supervision.
